


Mumbai's Gothic Architecture, the City's Lesser-known Legacy.

India's most lively city is also known for its old-world charm and is one of the most characteristically Victorian cities in the world.

The city is dotted with heritage structures of neoclassical and Victorian Gothic design. These edifices are ornate with lively colours, carvings of flying buttresses, lancet windows and stained glasses.

While this style was initially used in churches, it was soon adapted in the construction of public places and mansions.

However, it didn't take long for the city to develop its own architectural style. It was called the Mumbai Gothic architecture, which was a blend of Gothic and modern styles of the era. The architects also drew inspiration from European styles, which include Dutch roofs, Swiss timbering, German gables, Tudor casements and, of course, Indian features.



The Epicentre of Art Deco Architecture in Asia.

During the late 1930s, the architects of Mumbai introduced the city – to Art Deco designs. This new style of architecture used not only scientifically relevant materials but also propagated Western-style furniture and interiors.

The Art Deco style was easily accepted and accelerated the city's development. The middle-class population in Mumbai was growing due to the expanding port trade and Art Deco architecture, with an Indian touch, was used extensively in the construction of commercial spaces, residences and movie halls.

As a result, today Mumbai has the second-most Art Deco buildings in the world. The first being the city of Miami, in Florida, USA.

However, as was prevalent in those days, Art Deco structures tended to be no more than six storeys tall. You will soon witness Mumbai's first Art Deco Tower.













